Immediate safety is not a concern but intervention is required as soon as possible, or at least within 24 hours.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Behavior that appears bizarre or out of touch with reality Reports of current or previous domestic violence/stalking/sexual assault Significant emotional distress Vague written or verbal statements about intent to harm self or others Verbal aggression (no immediate threat of harm) 	Counseling Center AND/OR Behavioral Intervention Team Refer students to 24/7 care provided by TimelyCare at timelycare.com/sfcollege	352-395-5508 OR Go to sfcollege.edu/saysomething and complete the Concerning or Threatening Behavior Report.
